<b>Description</b>			
<p>When stripping quotes from input strings, exivsimple does not check for string length, thus dies with an array index out of bounds exception on input strings of length 0 or 1. This affects the AddMeta and ModifyMeta methods. I've verified that this exists in the latest code currently in the repository.</p>
