**Description**

Exiv2 defines MPReg:PersonLiveCID (ref <http://www.exiv2.org/tags-xmp-MPReg.html>) as per the table in the Microsoft documentation:

But note that below the table, the example uses "PersonLiveldCID", not "PersonLiveCID".

I have only seen examples of "PersonLiveldCID" in the wild, and as such, ExifTool uses this definition (see <http://130.15.24.88/exiftool/forum/index.php?topic=4274.msg20368#msg20368>).

Have you seen "PersonLiveCID" ever written by any Microsoft software? If not, I suggest standardizing on the tag actually written by the Microsoft software, "PersonLiveldCID".
