<p>I'm trying to add exif comments to a bunch of files and I found some weird behavior.</p> <p>Works fine! exiv2 -M "set Exif.Photo.UserComment This is my comment" file.jpg</p> <p>Works fine! (quoted my) exiv2 -M "set Exif.Photo.UserComment This is \"my\" comment" file.jpg</p> <p>Broken (quoted comment) exiv2 -M "set Exif.Photo.UserComment This is my \"comment\"" file.jpg</p> <p>It seems if the FINAL character of the comment is a " character the parser gets confused. I can "work around" the bug by doing:</p> <p>Work Around (last char not ") exiv2 -M "set Exif.Photo.UserComment This is my \"comment\"." file.jpg</p> <p>Is this normal?</p> <p>Scott</p>
